Primary Role:

The Firearms Director (Handgun) oversees and promotes the handgun shooting sports within the Sherwood Park Fish and Game Association.

Qualifications:

- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Board experience, either for profit or not-for-profit.
- Experience in the area of governance, stewardship, and/or strategic planning.
- Experience in organizational effectiveness and design.
- Active volunteer experience.
- Public speaking skills and experience.
- Conflict resolution and change management experience.
- Knowledgeable in the use of modern, distributed collaboration tools such as Microsoft Office, MS Teams, OneDrive.

Responsibilities:

- Makes serious commitment to participate actively in committee work and is a participant of at least one committee (Shooting).
- Provides written reports to board meetings, as required.
- Stays informed about committee matters, prepares themselves well for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports.
- Contributes to the effectiveness of the Board and its members.
- Performs other responsibilities as assigned by the Board.

General Accountabilities:

This position is responsible for promotion of the Association's activities related to handgun shooting sports.

Specific Accountabilities:

- Attend Board meetings.
- Provide leadership with respect to handgun shooting sports.
- Member of the Shooting Committee.
